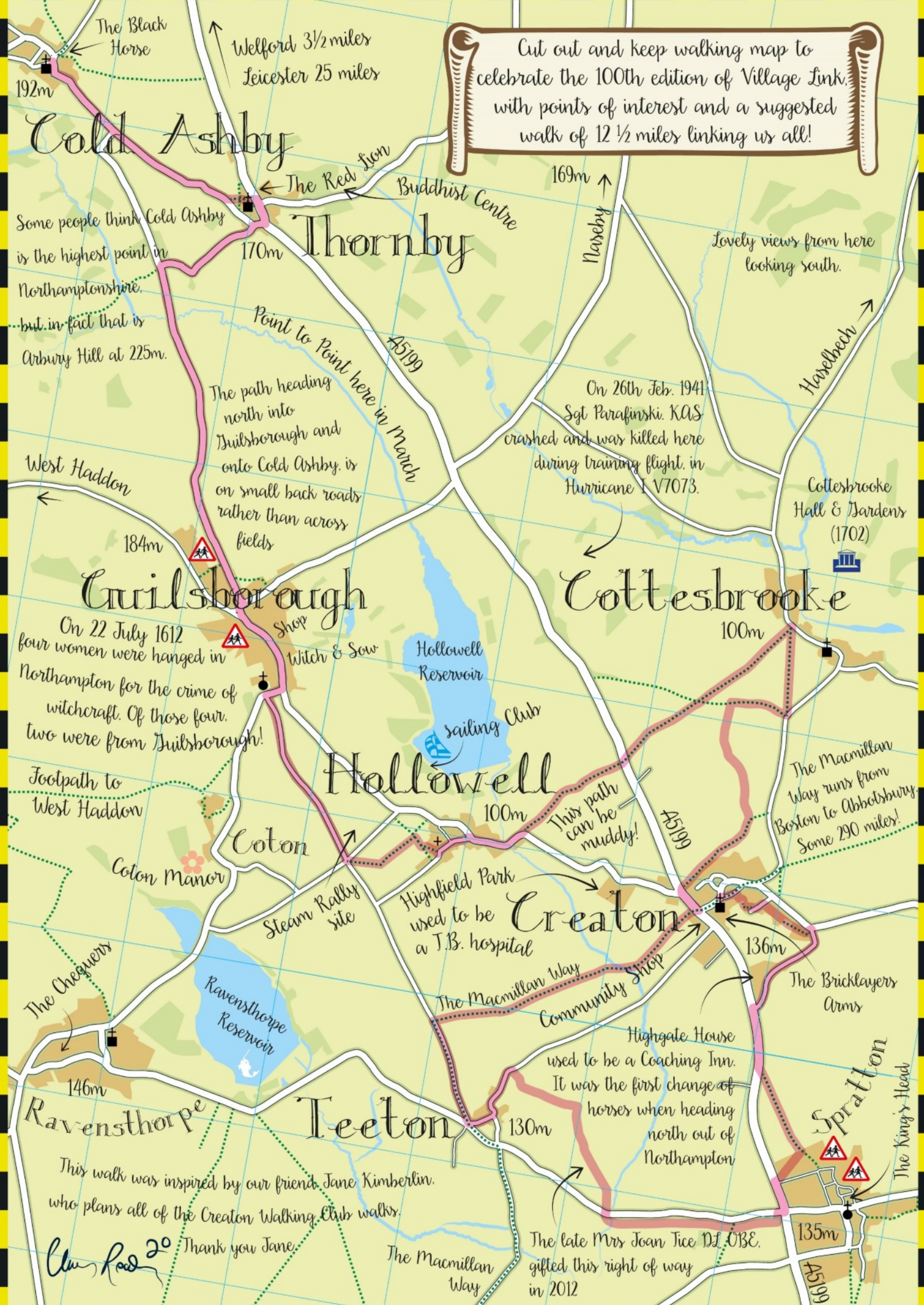


Cut out and keep walking map to celebrate the 100th edition of Village Link, with points of interest and a suggested walk of 12 1/2 miles linking us all!



Some people think Cold Ashby is the highest point in Northamptonshire, but in fact that is Arbury Hill at 225m.

On 22 July 1612 four women were hanged in Northampton for the crime of witchcraft. Of those four, two were from Thulborough!

On 26th Feb. 1941 Sgt Parafinski, KAS crashed and was killed here during training flight, in Hurricane J V7073.

Highgate House used to be a Coaching Inn. It was the first change of horses when heading north out of Northampton.
